1. The Applicant must be a legally recognized entity. Eligible entities include Companies registered under the Companies Act, 2013/1956, Partnerships, and Proprietorship firms possessing a valid GSTIN.
2. The Applicant should not be debarred/ blacklisted by any Government/PSU in India as on the date of submission of the Bid.
3. Applicants should be a profit-making company & should not have incurred losses in more than one year during the last 3 financial years ending on 31.06.2026.
4. Net worth of the Applicant should be positive.
5. The Applicant must submit a Manufacturer Authorization Form (MAF) from the respective OEMs.
6. The respective OEMs must strictly comply with all eligibility and technical qualifications specified in Annexure II and Annexure III.
